Our work extends well beyond the classroom: For example, we research, we write, we contribute to the ongoing operations of the University (serve on numerous committees), we network with professional organizations to promote MRU and fundraise and we are active participants in the academic governance of the University.

What we are currently advocating for:

- Decreasing reliance on contract faculty. We must find pathways for contract faculty to move into full-time roles. It is not fair to ask people to continuously apply for work and for the University to profit from cheap labour. Over the past years there has been a net decrease in the number of full-time faculty.
- Keeping class sizes small to ensure we maintain the calibre of education at MRU.
- Distributing workload to faculty through collegial and transparent processes.

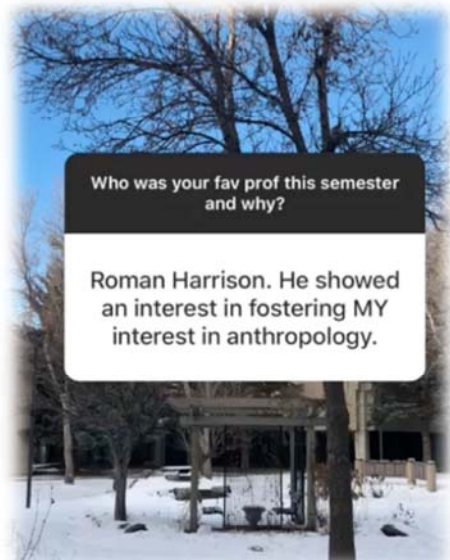

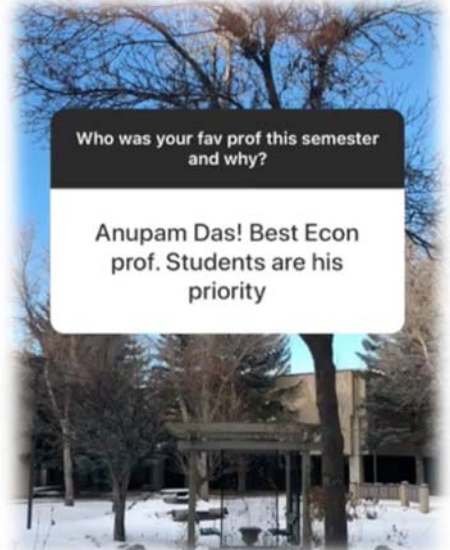
