A Message from your Diversity and Equity Officer

Over the past few weeks I've been reflecting on the message I wanted to share with you on this important day—what I would want to hear from the MRFA on March 8 in addition to a reaffirmation of the ongoing work taking place through the Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion Committee, the MRFA Executive, the Joint Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion Committee, and the MRFA 2025 Group. Much of said work overlaps initiatives I referenced in my February note in celebration of Black History Month.

In my short time as the DEC-O, I have seen one question come forward more than any other: what's the status of pay equity at MRU? The answer we've been given is that the University is reviewing those individual files that were identified as anomalous through the salary review process to see how each person was initially placed on the grid at point of hire. We've received no date for when that process is to be concluded.

Given the fundamental nature of equal pay, to not yet have a satisfactory resolution to this questions—in of itself—is a frustration and a re-affirmation of systemic, persistent gender inequity at MRU.

In light of this, the MRFA will host a virtual panel on the role of unions in obtaining gender equality in April 2022. Please stay tuned for the details.

On March 7, you received the updated 2022 MRFA census. We've added new sections to this year's census in order to better understand, track, and address your experiences and realities, both at MRU and with the MRFA. The Association is committed to treating your labour in completing the census with the care and significance it deserves.
